We are making PROVISIONAL plans for the children to perform the Nativity as shown below. Please try and keep the date free to come along. Each showing will last about 30 minutes and unfortunately we can only accommodate one visitor ** for each child and you can only attend on the date and time shown below. We have had a high number of Covid cases from September, therefore this will be dependent on the situation on the day and regulations from the Department of Education and the Executive. There will be a video taken which will be uploaded, in the event of us having to cancel for visitors and for those unable to attend in person. Face coverings, unless medically exempt, must be worn.

As P4 is a smaller class, 2 visitors per pupil can attend. 'Twins' in any of the classes can have one visitor each! (We hope to be able to have P5- P7 'perform' later in the year.)

Admission to Nursery September 2022 & Primary 1 September 2022

Application forms for both Nursery and Primary 1 should be completed online through the link on the Education Authority website www.eani.org.uk. The portal will be open from noon on Monday 10th January 2022 and will close at noon on Friday 28th January 2022.

Your child's birth certificate and any other necessary documentation should be uploaded to the document hub. The application form will tell you how to do this.

We are unable to hold an Open Evening like we did previously but the NURSERY school will be open on Saturday 18th December 2021 from 9am—1pm for prospective parents to view the facilities. As we enter the winter months with dark, dull mornings and slippery conditions it is essential for the safety of the pupils that all parents and carers read and follow this information carefully.


If you are not the person who normally drops off and collects your child then please share this note with those who do.

- Only those designated groups shown on the parking sign may enter the school car park. ('Soon to be new Mums' or those travelling with small babies are also able to park in the school carpark).





Snow/Emergency Closure, Bush PS & NU Winter 2021 - 2022

Main reasons for closure:

- PSNI/Met Office warning to only travel if absolutely essential.
- Adequate number of staff able to be in attendance.
- Can emergency services access the school quickly and safely should the need arise during the school day?

• Notification of closure:

Firstly, a message will be placed on our school website (www.bushprimaryschool.co.uk)

and the PTA Facebook page

Download the Schools NI app to receive notifications

Secondly, by text message to all families using the school text messaging service. This service uses the main mobile contact number which has been given to school. It is the responsibility of parents to ensure that school is notified of any changes to contact numbers. Thirdly, by notification to BBC NI News who will produce a list. A list of closures will be found at http://www.bbc.co.uk/newsni

School Bus:

If the bus does not come out to bring your child to school, assume (unless there has been a significant thaw) that it will not be bringing your child home and make arrangements to collect your child from school.

If it snows significantly during the course of the day assume there will be no bus in the afternoon and make arrangements to collect your child from school. The drivers do try to keep us up to date so you can also check with school.

On days when a **significant** fall occurs during the day we will try to send all children home at 1.30/1.45 pm in order to allow staff time to travel home in daylight and also to reduce parental journeys.

It would be highly unusual that school would close for snow but if you are in doubt, do not set out in the morning until you are sure school is open. A slightly later start will be acceptable.

Remember, staff may also be delayed so when dropping off your child, check teachers are present before you drive off. If we do get some snow, send your child to school with Wellingtons, hats, gloves etc so that those who wish to do so, can enjoy the snow!

Finally, please drive and walk carefully in and around school. At times we do have to close off the carparks as the entrance, even after clearing and salting can be very slippery.
